

Title VI Notice to the Public

Notifying the Public of Rights Under Title VI The Arizona Recreation Center for the Handicapped (ARCH)

The Arizona Recreation Center for the Handicapped (ARCH) hereby gives public notice that is the policy of the agency to ensure full compliance with the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, Executive Order 12898 on Environmental Justice, and related authorities and regulation in all programs and activities. Title VI requires that no person in the United States of America shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which ARCH received federal financial assistance. Additional protections are provided in other federal and state authorities for discrimination based on income status, limited English proficiency, religion, sex, disability, age, gender identity, or sexual orientation.

Any person who believes they have experienced discrimination under Title VI may file a complaint with the Arizona Recreation Center for the Handicapped (ARCH). Any such complaint must be filed with ARCH's Title VI Coordinator within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence.
